1	Sanctuary of Flora and Fauna of Iguaque: An ecological long hike from the high-Andean jungle to the moor (Páramo), where you can see the diversity of the flora and fauna. This leads to the sacred lake of Iguaque (3.600 m) the origin of the Muisca mythology. 2	Angel Step Route 1: The Angel Circuit, takes you to the “Piedra Movida” (moved stone), the Guatoque waterfall (80 meters tall), green pool, the Monquirá river, the Mogolla stone, and the angel step, one of the most amazing places in our region.
